During your sessions, you will master real skills that you will need as a diver with your Instructor devoting the maximum time to teach you safe and easy diving within the parameters of PADI Standards.

## How long?

PADI Courses are performance based, not time based. Your Instructor will make sure that you have mastered the performance requirements of simple skills before proceeding to the more elaborate ones.

This well programmed course consists of:

- Academics & Skill Development Sessions, both in Confined Water (Pool or Pool like environment) and Classroom,
- Open Water Training Dives ( Ocean Dives)
- Most of our training dives are conducted at Dive & Trek Resort a Marine Sanctuary in Bauan, Batangas.

## Pre-requisites:

- **Minimum age:** 10 yrs old for Junior Open Water Diver  
12 yrs old for Open Water Diver
- **Swimming:** If able to swim, any style, 200 yards/183 meters.
- **Medical History:** Fill out Medical History Form and Express Assumption of Risk form.  
If cannot swim, snorkel swim for 300 yards

## For Starters,

After successfully completing the course, you will be issued a **PADI OPEN WATER DIVER** or **\*Scuba Diver** certification.

This internationally recognized credential allows you to buy or rent scuba equipment, dive from resorts or charter boats and participate in diving activities without an Instructor present. It qualifies you to enroll in a PADI Continuing Education Dive Courses \*The Scuba Diver Certified Divers can only dive under the Supervision of a Dive Professional.
